Ramberg

- **Ramberg** famous for its stunning beach, The beach is surrounded by mountains and provides breathtaking views of the Norwegian Sea

Hamnøy

- **Hamnøy** is a charming fishing village situated in the Lofoten archipelago in Norway. Known for its scenic beauty, Hamnøy is characterized by its vibrant red and yellow wooden cabins (**rorbuer**) built on stilts along the waterfront.
- **Reine** an authentic living fishing village in Lofoten famous for its scenic location by the Arctic Ocean and majestic Lofoten peaks.

Stamsund & Ballstad

- **Ballstad** is well-situated for Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) sightings during the dark winter months
- **Viking Museum** the house is an impressive longhouse that provides visitors with an immersive experience of Viking Age life.





Tromso

- **Tromso** the largest urban area in Northern Norway and serves as a cultural, economic, and scientific hub in the region
- **Arctic Cathedral**, is a distinctive and iconic architectural landmark in Tromsø.
- A view from above at **Fjellheisen** Cable Car which offers breathtaking panoramic views of the city.
- **Whale Watching** is a popular activity, especially during certain times of the year when whales migrate through the nearby fjords and coastal waters
- **Reindeer Safari** offering visitors a chance to experience the indigenous Sami culture and interact with reindeer, which are an integral part of Sami tradition and livelihood.
- **Dog Sledding** It provides an exhilarating way to explore the Arctic landscape while being pulled by a team of energetic and well-trained sled dogs, usually Siberian Huskies or Alaskan Malamutes.(Additional charge apply)

- **Svalbard Global Seed Vault** secure backup facility provides security of the world's food supply against the loss of seeds in genebanks due to mismanagement, accident, equipment failures, funding cuts, war, sabotage, disease and natural disasters.
- **Snowmobile Safari** trip through the majestic nature to the east coast and see amazing sights like icebergs, old trappers' huts, glacier termini and Arctic animal life (Additional charge apply)

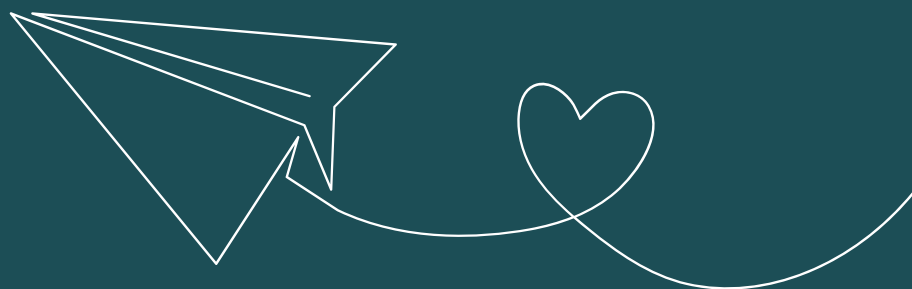

1. Minimum 7 pax for tour confirmation.
2. We practice self-help, self-cooked and backpacking way of traveling in Norway therefore please do not expect babysitting service like traditional travel agency.
3. Tour members can opt for restaurants dining (except for breakfast) or self cooked during the journey.
4. During the stay in Airbnb, tour members are required to clean up kitchen after meals preparation.
5. Proposed accommodations are subject to availability and changes due to unforeseen circumstances. Tour members to allocate the rooms in Air Bnb by themselves. Please note there maybe bunk beds in the accommodation.
6. We use 9 seater passenger van with 3 seats in a row during the tour. Please note 2 tour members to be seated in front row together with driver for 8 pax group.
7. Limited booth capacity each tour member is allowed to bring only 1 (ONE) check in luggage size not more than 43cmx64cmx27cm and 1 (ONE) SOFT travel bag not more than 50cmx30cmx20cm.
8. They may be More than 1 vehicle will be travelled concurrently during the journey for safety reason.
